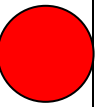

We have been climbing and have made some delicious fruit kebabs

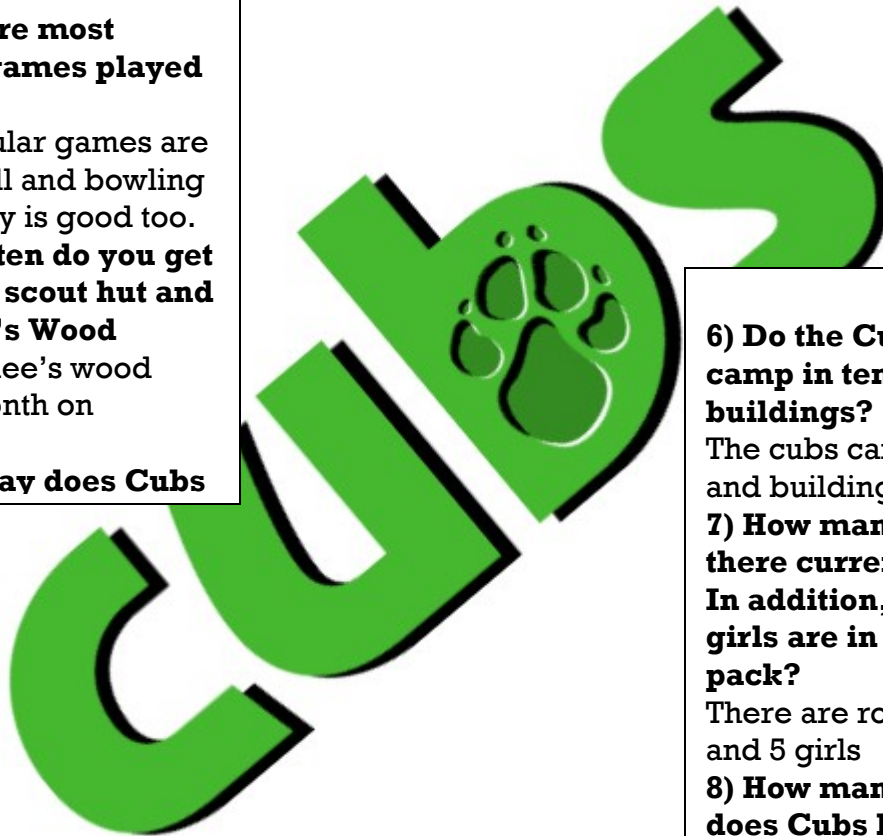
2) What are most popular games played at Cubs?

8) How many leaders does Cubs have? (Including me, you and Andy)

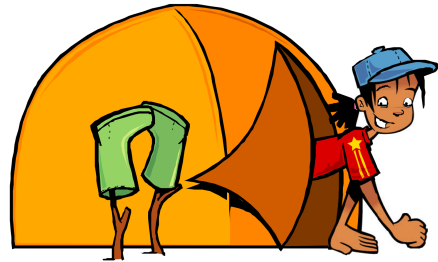
There are 5 leaders
