Group Chairman's Report

2015 saw Becky's first year as GSL and I am sure you will agree she has done a fantastic job. She has also been a great support to all the Leaders and both me and Colin.



As you may be aware, I was 'persuaded' to enter the London Triathlon in August as part of a team with two of my sons Steve, an ex-Beaver/Cub/Scout and Chris, now better known as Akela. We managed to complete the course in just over 3 hours. We're doing it again this year and hope to beat 3 hours. (More photos at *9thnorthwatford.co.uk/triathlon*)

Negotiations with Watford Community Housing Trust regarding renewal of both our and the 2nd North Watford leases have recently re-opened, supported by Roger Sands and Dave Collette, District Commissioner. We have made some progress and are hopeful of a resolution soon. In the meantime, the hut now requires quite a lot of maintenance work so we need assistance with both physical help and fund raising to pay for the repairs. If anyone is able to provide help or advice for either then you will be most welcome.

We have arranged for the roof to be repaired during the summer which will cost nearly £9,000 and will use all our contingency funds. In addition, there are two major jobs which need to be undertaken: new guttering around the building and insulation to the ceiling although neither can be done until the roof is repaired. I estimate that the cost of materials alone will be £250 for guttering and £750 for insulation

We would also like to refurbish the kitchen and toilets but, as you can see from the Group Accounts, cannot afford to hence this appeal for help.

Finally, thank you all for your continued support for the Leaders which I know they all appreciate.

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


